


# Autumn Term

## Year 3



### English

Fiction: The Adventures of the Dish and the Spoon.

Diary Writing – All about Dish and Spoon's travelling show.

Newspaper writing – Lets report Dish and Spoon for taking money.

Reading – Our focus is on understanding what we are reading and phonics.

In **Computing** we have been practising our skills of using a search engine to find fun facts. We will be researching all about magnets and discovering new things for our science unit.

Also, we will be learning how to stay safe on the internet.

In **RE** we have been finding out about Christians and other religions. We will be looking at the many Holy books and how they are all different and similar.

In **RSHE** we are developing our Social and Emotional skills which will include recognising their self-worth, setting personal goals and recognising feelings.

### Science

#### Forces and Magnets

To predict, plan and investigate how objects move on different surfaces.

To recognise push and pull forces in everyday life.

To secure our understanding of magnets: how they attract and repel and the different types of magnets.

In **Art** we are focusing our drawings on wildlife creatures. The children will be learning all about many artists who draw wildlife as well as artist who draw still life. The children will learning skills on how to do this and have a go themselves.

In **History** we are learning about the bronze age through to the Iron Age. The children will be finding out about the clothing, homes and tribes during these times.

In **Geography** the children will be learning about where the Bronze Age and Iron Age people immigrated to and locations around Britain what show evidence of these time periods like Skara Brae and the Great Orme mines.

### Maths

- To practice addition and subtraction of three-digit numbers
- To count up and down in 50s and 100s.
- To draw 2-D shapes and make 3-D shapes using modelling materials
- To recognise 3-D shapes in different orientations and describe them
- To identify right angles
- To identify horizontal and vertical lines and pairs of perpendicular and parallel lines
- To interpret and present data using bar charts, pictograms and tables
- To solve one-step and two-step questions using information presented in scaled bar charts and pictograms and tables

### Indoor PE

We are focusing on symmetry and asymmetry in gymnastics. Our aim is to work with a partner to create a routine based on the two elements above.

### Outdoor PE

Our outdoor sport is Netball. Our focus is attacking and defending. We are working in small groups to practice these skills and will work towards a 4v4 game of Netball.
