<u>September 2017-July 2018</u> To employ a qualified Sport's coach to deliver high quality provision to KS2 to teach Orienteering and Archery	£9,000	Instructor is monitored by outside agency. <u>April 2017-July 2018</u> To employ highly qualified sports coaches to deliver after school clubs – roller hockey, multi sports and gym club	(included in the above) +	Numbers have doubled since we charged parents for clubs. Every club is full.
<u>April 2017- July 2018</u> To provide sports provision during the holidays- daily 10 am to 3pm	£35 per child per week.	The summer club had 40+ children every day and was a fantastic success.
